HPV free

How you can help:

- Talk to your young ones about the importance of the HPV vaccine.
- Make sure your young ones receive their HPV vaccine at school. You can also get the HPV vaccine at your local council, at a doctor, Aboriginal Health Service or at some pharmacies.
- If young ones miss out on the HPV vaccine, arrange a catch up dose as soon as you can.

The HPV vaccine is provided free in Victorian secondary schools for all young ones aged about 12-13.

People aged 12-25 can also get a free catch-up dose of the HPV vaccine through their local council, at a doctor, Aboriginal Health Service or at some pharmacies.
