The Bachelor of Applied Social Science (Community Service) is three years in duration for a full time student, or six years duration for a part time student. In this course, your core subjects will comprise of 21 subjects. Each year consists of three Study Periods, also known as Trimesters.

The course contains 3 subject levels - Level 100, 200 and 300, guiding you from foundational through to more complex subjects.

- Level 200: 7 core subjects - 1 elective

- Level 300: 6 core subjects - 1 elective

- Level 300: 6 core subject - 2 electives
