Diploma of Counselling and Communication Skills

The Diploma of Counselling and Communication Skills is a one year course for a full time student, or over a two year duration for a part time student. Each year consists of three Study Periods, also known as Trimesters.

Core subjects - compulsory subjects that you must complete

This course comprises of 8 subjects that you are required to complete, following the order of the below Suggested Study Pattern.

Prerequisite subject - a subject you must complete before undertaking another subject Corequisite subject - a subject you must complete with another subject at the same time

RPL - Should you have any Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) credits that make you eligible for exemptions, please contact your Program Director to discuss further.

How to read the below Suggested Study Pattern (as a Full Time Student):

2 or 3 subjects per study period make up a full time study load.

You should read the Suggested Study Pattern from top to bottom, which would result in your three Study Periods (trimesters) looking as follows:

1st Study Period: COU103A, ISP102 and CTI103 (3 subjects)
2nd Study Period: COU104A, CMP105 and SCC106 (3 subjects)
3rd and final Study Period: PFP107 and MHC108 (2 subjects)
