The Master of Education (Reading and Literacy) is 1.5 years in duration for a full time student. Each year consists of three Study Periods, also known as Trimesters.

This course comprises of 8 subjects that you are required to complete: 6 core subjects and 2 elective subjects.

Prerequisite subject - a subject you must complete before undertaking another subject
