

Master of Education (Inclusive Literacies) (Advanced)

The Master of Education (Inclusive Literacies) (Advanced) comprises 16 subjects for a total of 160 credit points.

- Core subjects: 10 subjects
- Specialisations: Nil
- Electives: 6

The Master of Education (Inclusive Literacies) (Advanced) would normally be undertaken over 2 years full time study or 4 years part time study.

To graduate with this qualification, a student must satisfactorily complete 16 subjects. 10 core subjects and 6 Electives of 10 credit points each, for a combined course total of 160 credit points.

Core subjects - compulsory subjects that you must complete

Elective subjects - subjects you can choose from the Elective Bank below

This course comprises of 16 subjects that you are required to complete: 10 core subjects and 6 elective subjects.

Prerequisite subject - a subject you must complete before undertaking another subject
