

HLT54121 Diploma of Nursing

The Diploma of Nursing is conducted over 5 Study Periods or trimesters with each one consisting of a 12 week teaching period.

**This course comprises of 25 subjects that you are required to complete following the order of the below Required Study Pattern.**

**Prerequisite subject** - a subject you must complete before undertaking another subject

**Corequisite subject** - a subject you must complete with another subject at the same time

RPL - Should you have any Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) credits that make you eligible for exemptions, or you are eligible for course credit transfer please contact your Program Director to discuss further.
