8 subjects per year make up a full time study load, following a **3 subjects-3 subjects-2 subjects** pattern across the year's three Study Periods (Trimesters).

As an example: Following the below pattern, the subjects in your first year would be:

Your first Study Period: PUBH6000, PUBH6002 and PUBH603 (3 subjects) Note: Students must enrol in PUBH6000 in the first study period

Your second Study Period: PUBH6005 PUBH6206 and STAT6200 (3 subjects) Your third Study Period: PUBH6001 and 1 Specialisation subject (2 subjects) Your four Study Period: PUBH6007 and 1 Elective subject (2 subjects)

Your fifth Study Period: 2 Elective subjects (2 subjects)
