Your first Study Period: PUBH6000, PUBH6002 and PUBH6003 (3 subjects) Note: Students must enrol in PUBH6000 in the first study period

Your second Study Period: PUBH6005 PUBH6206 and STAT6200 (3 subjects)

Your third Study Period: PUBH6001 and PUBH6007 (2 subjects)

Your fourth, fifth and sixth Study Periods: Students will select 1 Specialisation subject and 7 Elective subjects
