## BCOM16 Bachelor of Commerce

The Bachelor of Commerce is three years in duration for a full-time student, or six years duration for a part-time student. Each year consists of three Study Periods, also known as Trimesters.

Core subject - a compulsory subject that you must complete Elective subject - a subject you must choose from an Elective Bank

Pre-requisite subject - a subject you must complete before undertaking another subject.

This course comprises 24 subjects that you are required to complete: 10 core subjects and 14 elective subjects.

The course contains 3 subject levels - Level 100, 200 and 300 - guiding you from foundational through to more complex subjects.

• Level 100: 6 core subjects.

• Level 200: 3 core subjects.

Level 300: 1 core subject.

At least FIVE electives must come from the Bachelor of Commerce (BCOM) Elective Bank (see page 2). The remaining electives can come from either the BCOM Elective Bank OR from the Bachelor of Business (BBUS) Elective Bank (see page 4). In total, you must choose AT LEAST FIVE (5) Level 300 elective subjects and no more than four (4) Level 100 electives.

RPL - Should you have any Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) credits that make you eligible for exemptions, please contact your Program Director to discuss further.

How to read the below Suggested Study Pattern (as a full-time Student):

8 subjects per year make up a full time study load, following a 3 subjects -3 subjects -2 subjects pattern across the year's three Trimesters.

As an example: Following the below pattern, the subjects in your first year would be: Your first Study Period: BIZ101, COMR2008 and 1 elective (3 subjects) We strongly recommend taking BIZ102 as your first elective Your second Study Period: FINA2006, ECON2002 and STAT2000 (3 subjects) Your third Study Period: LAW2000 and 1 elective (2 subjects)

Studying Part-Time? You would still follow the below sequence from top to bottom, but with fewer subjects per Study Period.





A note about Pre-requisite Chains

The Accounting and Finance electives in the BCOM Elective Bank must be completed in a specific order, because pre-requisites link them together into a chain. The diagrams below illustrate the order.



For example: You must complete ACCT2000 (in one trimester) before taking ACCT2007 (in the next trimester). The minimum time required to complete all the ACCOUNTING electives is 5 trimesters.



The minimum time required to complete all the FINANCE electives is 4 trimesters.

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## **Recommended Study Plans for different careers**

The Bachelor of Commerce is a very versatile degree - your choice of elective subjects should match your career aspirations.

If you wish to work in General Commerce (Manager), follow the recommended study plan shown above.

If you wish to work in the Accounting industry, follow the recommended study plan at the top of Page 3.

## Professional Accreditation

The CPA (Certified Practising Accountants) and the CAANZ (Chartered Accountants of Australia and New Zealand) are professional associations within the Accounting industry. Membership into either one of them is a sign of quality and high ethical standards that professional accountants aspire to. The Bachelor of Commerce degree has been professionally accredited so that it can be used towards entry into the entrance exam for an associate membership with either of these professional bodies, provided the correct combination of elective subjects is chosen.

For a direct pathway into a CPA or CAANZ Associate Membership, your course must include ACCT2000, ACCT2002, ACCT2004, ACCT2005, ACCT2006, ACCT2007, LAW2001 and

LAW2002. By following the recommended study plans for Accounting on the next page, you will achieve Professional Recognition from the CPA AND the CAANZ.

Please note that <u>full</u> membership of either professional body requires at least 1 year of the professional experience, plus passing an entrance exam (operated by the professional bodies themselves, not Torrens University).
