WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PREPARE FOR MY NEXT AUDIT?

- Obtain a copy of FSSC V5 scheme documents

- Obtain a copy of ISO 22000:2018

- Undertake a gap analysis to help identify the gaps in your current certification in order to address and meet any new requirements
- Ensure that any new competence needs are met and create awareness for all parties that have an impact on the effectiveness of the FSSC 22000 audit
- Update the existing Food Safety Management System to meet the new requirements and provide verification of effectiveness through your internal audit program

WHAT IS THE TRANSITION PERIOD?

- All audits in 2020 will be to FSSC V5

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T TRANSITION TO FSSC V5 BY THE END OF 2020?

- Your FSSC V4.1 certification may no longer be valid

WHEN CAN I TRANSITION TO FSSC V5 INCORPORATING ISO 22000:2018?

- You must transition during your FSSC scheduled audit in 2020

WILL ADDITIONAL AUDIT TIME BE REQUIRED TO TRANSITION?

- No extra time is added when auditing the new version

WILL FSSC V5 AUDIT DURATIONS INCREASE?

- No

WILL THE DATES ON MY CERTIFICATE CHANGE?

- No – your certification dates will remain the same

WILL MY CERTIFICATE NUMBER CHANGE?

- No – your certificate number will remain the same
