WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PREPARE FOR MY NEXT AUDIT?

- Obtain a copy of ISO 2200:2018 [<https://www.iso.org/publication/PUB100430.html>]
- Undertake a gap analysis to help identify the gaps in your current certification in order to address and meet any new requirements
- Ensure that any new competence needs are met and create awareness for all parties that have an impact on the effectiveness of the ISO 22000 audit
- Update the existing Food Safety Management System to meet the new requirements and provide verification of effectiveness through your internal audit program

WHAT IS THE TRANSITION PERIOD?

- There is a 3 year migration period for all certified 22000:2005 clients
- All ISO 22000:2005 clients will need to have migrated by COB 18th June 2021

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T TRANSITION TO ISO 22000:2018 BY 19TH JUNE 2021?

- Your ISO 22000:2005 certification will no longer be valid

WHEN CAN I MIGRATE TO ISO 2200:2018?

You can migrate during your next:

- Surveillance audit; or
- Recertification audit; or
- At a special audit

WILL ADDITIONAL AUDIT TIME BE REQUIRED TO MIGRATE?

- No extra time is added when doing the new version at a recertification audit
- Typically 0.5 day will be added to a surveillance audit duration to audit the new requirements of ISO 22000:2018. For multi-site certifications this may vary, please refer to your SAI Global contact to discuss your personal requirements

WILL ISO 22000:2018 AUDIT DURATIONS INCREASE?

- No

WILL THE DATES ON MY CERTIFICATE CHANGE?

- No – your certification dates will remain the same

WILL MY CERTIFICATE NUMBER CHANGE?

- No - your certificate number will remain the same

I HAVE AN FSSC CERTIFICATE, WHY DOES THIS CHANGE TO ISO22000 AFFECT ME?

- As FSSC 22000 is based on the existing ISO 22000 standard, you will need to familiarise yourself with the new changes in order to remain compliant. Please refer to the FSSC 2200 transition policy to be issued at <http://www.fssc22000.com>
