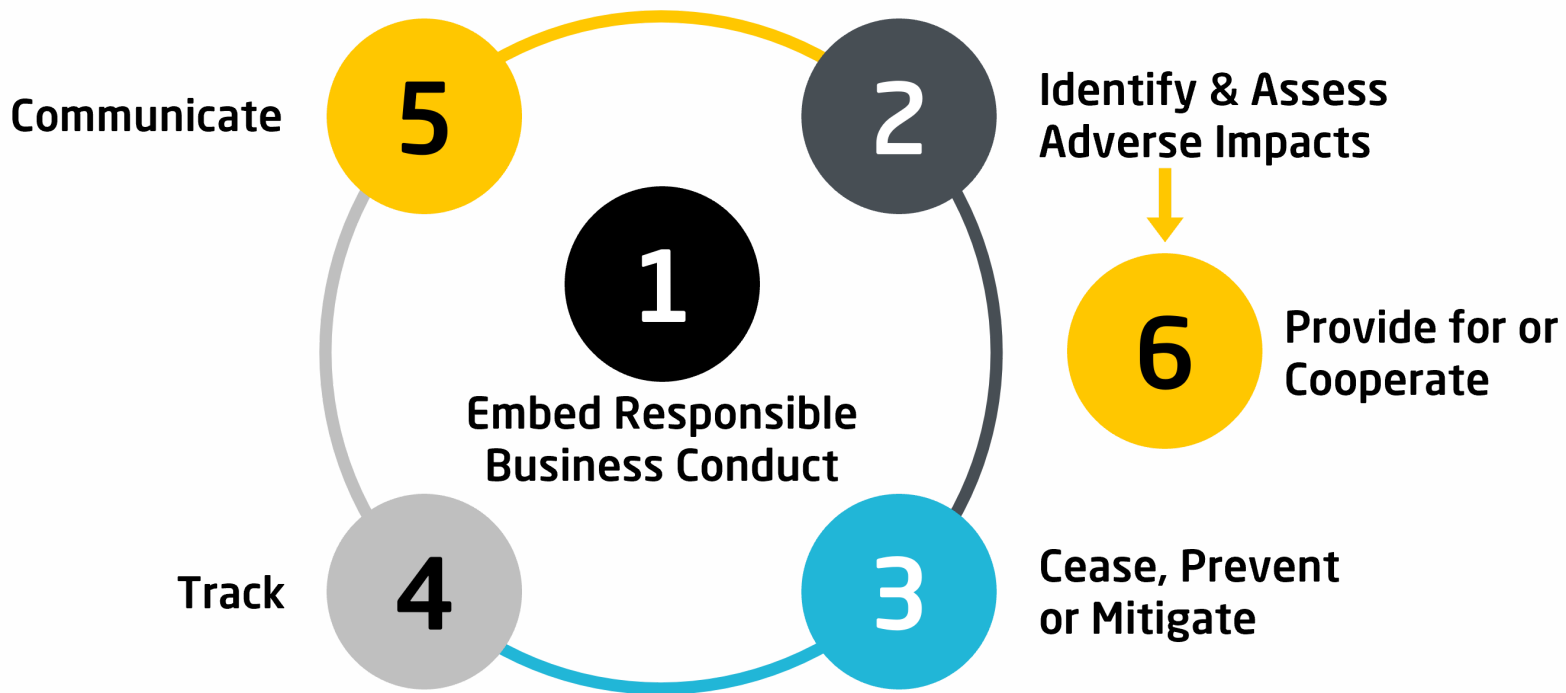


# The Modern Slavery Flywheel

To effectively eradicate modern slavery in the supply chain, organisations must adopt a flywheel approach to continually improve.



## 1 Embed Responsible Business Conduct into Policies & Management Systems

Adopt and clearly communicate to suppliers and the public your company policy on modern slavery and build internal capacity to support its improvement.

## 3 Cease, Prevent or Mitigate Adverse Impacts

Report findings of the supply chain risk assessment to senior management and devise and implement a strategy for risk management.

## 5 Communicate How Impacts are Assessed

Publicly report on supply chain due diligence policies and practices including its improvement.

## 2 Identify & Assess Adverse Impacts

Review your supply chains to identify risks and assess risks of adverse impacts in light of the standards of their supply chain policy.

## 4 Track Implementation and Results

Regularly review how your supply chain risk management is performing in relation to your policy. An effective way of tracking this is through 3rd party certification.

## 6 Provide for, or Co-Operate in Remediation where appropriate
