

# Oobleck Goo Fun!

Make your own Oobleck Goo! Touch it quickly and it won't stick to you, beware of touching it slowly though! Here is how to make the sticky goo, without any glue!

## Ingredients

- 1 cup of water
- 1 and 1/2 cups of cornstarch
- A few drops of food colouring (optional)
- Bowl
- Stirrer to mix your Goo with

- 1 Pour your water into a bowl and add the cornstarch a little bit at a time.
- 2 Keep stirring until it has a gooey consistency. You may want to use your hands at this point!
- 3 When the oobleck is just right, slowly add food colouring, if you want. This can be a challenge to get it mixed properly.
- 4 Time to play! Observe how the oobleck reacts to touching it quickly, and then touching it slowly.
