Event Guidelines

We've made it even easier for you to share Norwex at your events. The following are the new informal rules related to fairs, farmers markets or other vendor events.

Consultants are permitted to operate temporary booths to promote Norwex products at fairs, farmers markets and trade shows. It's required that you inform the Compliance department via email that you'll be operating a temporary booth prior to the event. Notification must include the location's address, the dates and times of the event and must include the names of the Consultant(s) who will be participating in the event.

- The booth must be staffed at all times by knowledgeable Consultants.
- The Consultant shall be solely responsible for complying with any insurance requirements imposed by the fair or trade show.
- Each Consultant is responsible for contacting the local authorities regarding any required permits or other documentation with regard to participating in the trade show, fair or other event. If a permit or other documentation is required, the Consultant must submit a copy of the permit or other documentation to Norwex prior to the event.
- A Norwex reserves the right to restrict attendance, as is deemed necessary.

Please note that if more than one Consultant wants to participate at a local farmers market or other vendor event, you'll need to handle that in a friendly and cooperative way between yourselves. No one has the sole right to participate at a vendor event.
