Avoid Damage to Conmet Digital Sensors During Wheel End Maintenance

Refer to the <u>ConMet Digital Installation Guide</u> and the <u>ConMet Service Manual</u> for all sensor and wheel end service, inspection, reassembly, and reinstallation instructions.

If PreSet Plus SmartHub™ sensors are installed on the hub being serviced:

- SmartHub sensors are located on the hub barrel, as shown in **Figure 1**
- Due to the sensor profile, the sensor may interfere with sliding the wheel over the hub barrel during wheel removal
- **BEFORE** wheel removal, rotate the hub so the SmartHub sensor is facing the ground, as shown in **Figure 2**. This should allow adequate space for the wheel to travel along the top of the hub barrel when sliding the wheel off with minimal obstruction.







If SmartAir™ TPMS sensors are installed on the tires being serviced:

- SmartAir™ TPMS sensors are located on tire valve stems, as shown in Figure 3
- If a SmartAir TPMS sensor needs to be removed for service, return to the same tire position after service
